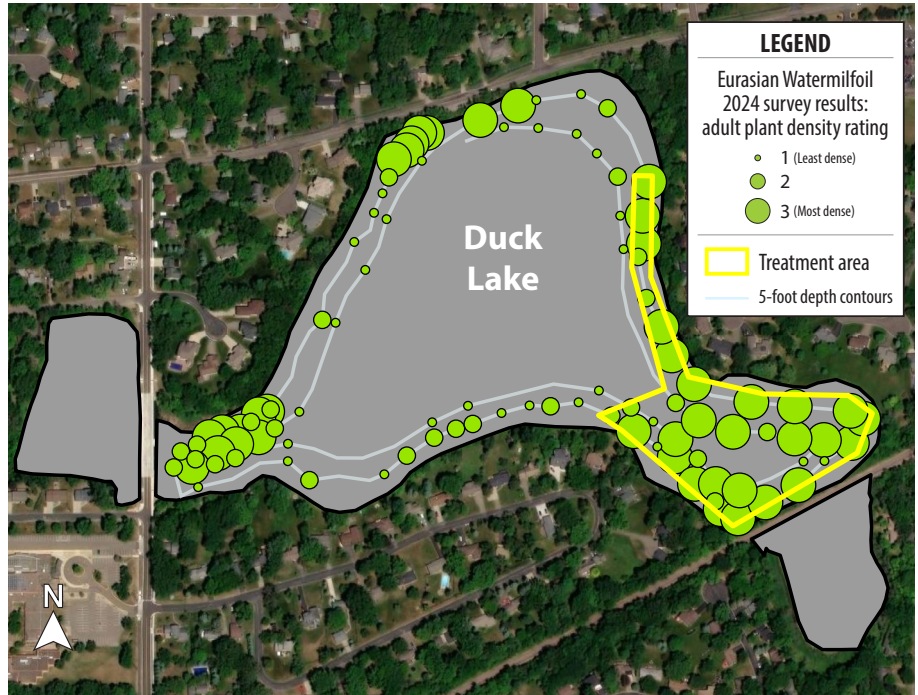


RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Eurasian Watermilfoil (EWM), an invasive aquatic plant, using an approved aquatic herbicide.

Staff perform surveys to identify areas in the lake with the highest density of the aquatic invasive plant. The size of the treatment areas is restricted by MnDNR permit requirements.

The treatment area for the lake will be 6.85 acres. The map shows the treatment area outlined in yellow.

RPBCWD will work with a contractor to apply the aquatic herbicide. *The treatment will occur at NO COST to residents.*



After a **ProcellaCOR** treatment, MnDNR recommends not using the water for these activities for these number of days:



Swimming
No restriction



Drinking
No restriction



Irrigation
5 days

What: Herbicide treatment (ProcellaCOR)

Where: Within designated area(s) on lake

Why: To control Eurasian Watermilfoil to benefit native plants and water quality.
Recreational access is not the focus of the treatment.

When: **June 19th**, subject to change due to weather
