

RESOLUTION NO. 23-043
Riley-Purgatory-Bluff Creek Watershed District
Board of Managers

Authorizing execution of cost share agreements with the City of Eden Prairie for the installation of native vegetation, a bee lawn, and an energy dissipator at 8107 Eden Prairie Rd

Manager Koch offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Manager Pedersen:

WHEREAS Riley-Purgatory-Bluff Creek Watershed District's 2018 10-Year Watershed Management Plan identifies and allocates funding to implement a cost-share program to provide incentives for BMPs; and

WHEREAS RPBCWD staff and the Watershed Stewardship Grant committee reviewed the application for the proposed native vegetation establishment, bee lawn installation, and energy dissipator and determined the project would meet RPBCWD goals to minimize the negative impacts of erosion and sedimentation, to use natural materials and bioengineering for the maintenance and restoration of shorelines, to minimize pollutant loading to water resources, and to promote infiltration to reduce runoff, improve water quality, and promote aquifer recharge.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the RPBCWD Board of Managers authorizes the administrator, with advice of counsel, to enter the attached agreement with the City of Eden Prairie, substantially in the form of the attached, for a cost not to exceed \$11,355, as finalized with such nonsubstantive changes as are necessary to implement the intent of the managers.
